Temple Retains Flexibility in Driveway Design

The City of Temple has recently adopted a parking ordinance in effort to keep vehicles from being parked or abandoned in areas of a yard that cause neighborhood blight. In doing so, they included language that impacted the way driveways are to be designed.

Understanding the apprehension this caused our leaders on behalf our members, TABA worked closely with staff to assure flexibility remained in this portion of the ordinance to provide the ability for current driveway design to endure.

In making sure the City would continue to accommodate designs that work, staff added language that provides for exhibits of designs that will be approved by right—several designs have already been submitted. If you would like to submit exhibits to staff for inclusion, please submit them to the Planning Department so that they can be considered.

Ideally, this will remove the burden of having to go to the planning director for approval of driveway designs that are fairly routine. We are hopeful that this provision will retain flexibility in the driveway design process for our members.

During final Council reading at which the ordinance was adopted, Council verified with the staff that the requirements for maximum driveway widths [24 feet plus flares for two car garages] would be measured at the property line. Staff specifically answered in the affirmative to the Council's direct question that the ordinance provides that driveways can be widened past the property line within specific parameters to accommodate handicap situations and other needs for additional driveway width.

It was understandable that several of our members became more and more apprehensive about the document as they gave it more thought--even up until the second and final reading of the ordinance. Design flexibility was clearly a continuing concern. City leadership bent over backwards to work with

TABA members on this ordinance, tweaking the document even up until the time of the final Council meeting. This isn't standard operating procedure for the City or for TABA. They truly went above and beyond. Please join me in thanking them for once again showing their willingness to regulate in an inclusive manner that benefits the entire community. We are very fortunate to operate in such an environment and credit is due to the great leadership we have in place in this City.

Change Remains Constant

Join TABA in welcoming newly named **President of the Temple Chamber of Commerce, Bourdon Wooten**. Mr. Wooten has been serving as Acting President since January. His leadership was made official on June 1st. Mr. Wooten has lived and worked in Temple since 2002. Prior to his appointment he was President/Market Manager for Cumulus Media, Inc.


