Happy November everyone!

As we march towards the end of 2011, I wanted to take a minute to update everyone on the status of the Government Affairs Committee. Our committee met last month to discuss our priorities for 2012, and we received some very good feedback from our members. While we continue to focus on outstanding items from 2011, we also added some items to our list that we hope will make the lives on jurisdictions, as well as our members, much easier.

Some of the first items we hope to address include simplifying the design review process at the City of Temple, as well as working on ways in which we might help streamline the inspections process to keep applicants better informed on the status of their projects/inspections. There are also a few clean up items that we are going to be working on with respect to the first phase of the Unified Development Code at the city. As mentioned, we received some good feedback and while there were no major issues of concern, it is our hope that we can partner with Temple area jurisdictions to make everyone's lives easier on these and other items.

City of Temple Charter Amendment Vote

Tuesday, November 8th: Voters will head to the polls to vote on 10 constitutional amendments, as well as changes to the City Charter for those of you that live in the City of Temple. While you are certainly free to vote how you wish, the **TABA HOMEPAC** has endorsed an "AGAINST" vote on amending the City Charter. They have also contributed \$5,000 in an effort to retain the existing charter. Please get out and exercise your right to vote!

City of Temple IRC/IBC

The City of Temple is currently finalizing changes to their IRC/IBC for 2011. They are expected to be adopted towards the end of the month, and we are supporting the changes. The City has involved us in their deliberations from the start, and we have provided our feedback to them. The updates to the code are currently in front of the City Council, and we expect them to be adopted with the TABA-supported amendments, which are minor.

The 2012 HOMEPAC Skeet Shoot will occur on Tuesday, September 25th, 2012. Yes, its a long way out. But PLEASE get this on your calendars early. 



Booking continues for the 2012 Home & Garden Show scheduled for February 25 and 26, 2012 at the Bell County Expo Center. If you are interested in participating in the largest Home & Garden Show in Central Texas then please call now to reserve your spot. You can download the show layout and booth price guide by <u>clicking here</u>. To get started, please call the office at 254-773-0445 with the layout in hand so we can go over what booths are open. A deposit of 2/3 of your total booth cost is required at time of booking and booths booked before December 1st must be paid in full by December 31st. Call early for best booth locations.

This show takes up over 75,000 square feet of exhibit space boasting over 125 exhibitors showing anything from homebuilding to flooring to plants to pots and pans to mops and brooms. There is something for everybody and every exhibitor is welcome. The show typically brings in around 4,500 people througout the three days it is open which includes the private showing at the Friday night Preview Party. It is a cost effective way to market your product or service to thousands of people in a short period of time and we encourage you to take a good, hard look at participating.

If you cannot afford the time to actually be in the show, you may consider being a show sponsor. There are two levels of sponsorship. 1st level is our Show Partner level costing \$2000. At this level, your company logo is shown on all of our advertising which includes TV and print as well as spoken in the TV commercial. Your banner will also appear in the Expo domed floor area and recognized numerous times throughout the entire show. If \$2000 is too pricey, you might go for the \$250 banner sponsor level which gets your banner in the domed room floor and recognized several times throughout the entire show.
