

#### **City of Temple**

We continue to work with the City of Temple on a number of development related issues, from Perimeter Street fees to UDC corrections to Commercial permitting and a host of other items. The Government Affairs Committee has a strong technical subcommittee which has been advancing these issues over the last few months. The City is also looking at adopting their post-construction ordinance sometime in May, an ordinance that is mandated by the State of Texas, and something that TABA has worked with them on a continual basis for the last 2 years. Make no mistake about it: this ordinance has been handed to cities, including Temple, is an unfunded mandate, and we are working to insure that the city has the necessary funding to implement the ordinance.

#### Would you like to serve on a board or commission?

I am currently looking for industry related volunteers to help insure that the cities have a strong candidate pool to draw from as they appoint members to a variety of boards and commissions. No experience is necessary, but we certainly appreciate having members with some form of industry expertise on these boards and commissions. There are a number of boards, including things

such as Electrical Board, Tree Board, Building and Standards Commission, Planning and Zoning, among other things. We currently have a number of industry related professionals on these, but we are always looking for more. The time commitment for many of them is less than 1 meeting per month (many meet on as as-needed basis), but the value to our industry is priceless. 
