Several elections will take place in 2014, these include the March 4th Primary Election for state and county officials; the May 10<sup>th</sup> Local Election; and the November 4<sup>th</sup> General Election.

#### Note from the Executive Officer:

TABA has recently had a number of exchanges with Temple City Manager David Blackburn—now with the City for more than nine years. The list of accomplishments that Temple has seen under Mr. Blackburn's watch is long and impressive. TABA is very fortunate to have such a fine person to deal with during his tenure and we will continue to work with Mr. Blackburn and his staff as issues arise that impact our industry.

Example of the concerns and issues that we have recently presented to the City of Temple include:

**Construction site theft** is a major concern. I have heard from builders throughout the community that they are experiencing significant losses, I estimate ~50 homes have been vandalized or broken into in the last month or two alone.

Adoption of the **2012 IRC/IEC** is an issue that we believe needs a great deal of discussion. We have been informed that the Cities of Temple and Belton are considering moving to the latest version of the code sooner rather than later. TABA has suggested that our goal should be to review the new codes so as to educate the development community and the inspectors before adoption at the end of the year or early next year. This would allow all parties to ramp up to the coming changes. We will keep you posted as we

learn more about the pending code changes.
