*Please remember to vote YES to pass Proposition 1- The November 2014 statewide ballot proposition is a constitutional amendment authorized by SJR 1 which legislators approved last year. The amendment would authorize annual disbursements from the state's oil and gas production tax collections to the State Highway Fund. An estimated \$1.7 billion would be transferred into the State Highway Fund in the first year alone. The amendment would provide a significant step toward meeting the unmet funding needs for transportation projects in Texas.

Slate for Your 2015 Board of Directors



Governor Perry Proclaims October 2014 "Careers In Construction Month"

At the request of the Texas Association of Builders and the Texas Builders Foundation, Governor Rick Perry signed a proclamation declaring October 2014 as "Careers in Construction Month" to increase public awareness and appreciation of construction craft professionals and the entire construction workforce.

The Texas Association of Builders, an affiliate of the National Association of Home Builders, has 28 local home builders associations and nearly 10,000 members across Texas, representing over 702,500 jobs and more than \$31.1 billion annually in the Texas economy. Texas' residential construction industry is facing a shortage of skilled workers and over the next five years 20 percent of skilled laborers in the construction industry will retire. With an estimated 1,300 people moving to Texas every day, the need for quality, affordable housing will continue to be in demand. A worker shortage delays the cost of the project, adding to the cost of the home, and pricing thousands of households out of average-priced homes in Texas.

The 83rd Texas Legislature passed House Bill 5, the comprehensive education reform bill, that gives high school students a choice in their post-graduation path, allowing them to prepare for college, or choosing elective courses that prepare them for employment immediately upon graduation from high school by, for example, earning construction industry or trade certifications. The mission of the Texas Builders Foundation, the charitable arm of the Texas Association of Builders, is to support and develop the future of Texas' construction workforce by providing scholarships to students who are enrolled in construction-related programs in Texas' technical and trade schools and colleges and universities.

By designating October 2014 as "Careers in Construction Month," the Governor has provided the Association and Foundation with an additional tool in our efforts to educate the youth of Texas on the construction industry as a professional career path," said Eddie Martin, Chairman of the Texas Builders Foundation, Texas Association of Builders Past President, and President and CEO of Tilson Home Corporation. "On behalf of the Texas Association of Builders and the Texas Builders Foundation, I want to thank Governor Perry for helping us to raise awareness of the construction industry as a worthy career option."




promote your business, we also navigate the political waters to help provide a pro-business environment.

What is the Spike Club?

The NAHB Spike Club is composed of all of the individual members and employees of members in local associations who have attained Spike status. It is a vehicle to recognize these members for their outstanding achievements in member recruitment and retention in their local home builders association.

How do I earn Spike Credits?

Individuals earn Spike Credits by sponsoring new members, and by those new members retaining their membership. Spike credits have the following values: 1.0 credit for new Builder or Associate members and 0.5 credit for new council members, Affiliate memberships, and Builder and Associate renewal memberships.

What is one example of a Spike Club perk?

Other than bragging rights... Spikes can attend the NAHB Spike Party & Directors' Reception held each year during the International Builders' Show. The Spike Party & Director's Reception recognizes and honors Spikes across the country for their continued commitment to membership development. To qualify to attend the Spike Party & Director's Reception, each Spike must have a minimum of 6 credits and must earn at least one new member credit between November 1 2013 - October 31 2014.
